Contestant Qualifications:

- Must be a current resident of SV Village or SV Township.
- Fall into one of the following age categories :

Prince & Princess (grades K - 3), Jr. King & Queen (grades 4 - 7), King & Queen (Must be in grades 8-12, and single)

- Cannot have previously won the title in that age category
- Contestants will appear in Dress attire, except as noted.

The chosen King/Queen will receive \$50. 1st Runner-up will receive \$25 and 2nd Runner-Up will also receive \$25. Prizes will be distributed at the end of a successful reign.
